Superheroes



This half term we will be learning...

Topic:

Our topic this half term will be all around the theme of superheroes and ourselves. Children will be looking at what helps us to stay healthy and will be thinking about their likes and dislikes. We will read the story 'Supertato', and make our own super veg! We will also look at what makes people special and linking this to superpowers and the Olympics.

Maths:

We will be focusing on number and place value, measuring length and weight, addition and subtractions as well as shape. Children will take part in lots of practical activities to develop their knowledge and confidence of the number system. This will then support their ability to add and subtract number to 20. We will then look at 2d shapes and their names as well as finding shapes in the environment.

Read Write Inc:

Children will be developing their reading and spelling knowledge through daily phonics sessions.

P.E:


Please bring P.E kits on a Monday to leave in school for the full week.
